EXPLORERS LANGUAGE, WRITING AND DOT-TO-DOT DRAWING BOOK

Aim / Description:

Using the dot-to-dot pictures and dashed writing familiarise students with the names of some of the animals that live in the tank and some interesting facts about them.

Materials:

- Pencils and colouring materials
- Explorers Language, Writing and Drawing Book

Activity:

Step 1. Get students to join the dot-to-dot pictures and colour in the pictures.

Step 2. Get the students to read and discuss the descriptions about each fish out loud.

Outcome:

Students will have developed skills:

- understanding and learning about seashore animals.
- learning English and Irish names of the animals.
- drawing and creative work.
