## Safety on the Seashore Code

### Aim / Description:

By completing the Safety on the Seashore Code students will learn about what the key areas they need to watch out for while on the seashore.

### Materials Required:

Art materials: including crayons, paint, markers, magazines etc

### Activity:

1. Discuss with students what they need to watch out for so as to stay safe on the seashore.
2. Get the students (individually or in groups) to create a Safety on the Seashore Code collage - identifying hazardous situations on the seashore and how they can be avoided.
3. The following hazards and safety measures should be discussed:
  - Wearing Safe clothing
  - Adhering to Warning Signs
  - Avoiding Cliffs (rocks falling)
  - Avoiding muddy shores
  - Take it slow – avoid running and jumping over wet slippery rocks
  - Tread carefully over seaweed – as it often covers uneven surfaces, hidden rock pools and holes.
  - Keep away from the waters edge
  - Watch out for waves – especially near rocks
  - Avoid hazardous waste and litter
